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MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION

Submit one original manuscript and figures (photographs/slides, illustrations, and radiographs) and one electronic copy on disc or via e-mail to Mary Byers, *IJO* Managing Editor, 315 Bristol Road, Chatham, Illinois 62629 USA, marybyers@comcast.net. Author (one designated author if more than one author) must include address, telephone, fax, and e-mail address on the cover letter. *To protect the anonymity of the author during manuscript review, author's name should appear only on the cover title page.* If the manuscript is written in a language other than English, the author(s) must submit an English translation as well as in the author(s)' native language. **The manuscript must be original and submitted exclusively to IJO.**

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MANUSCRIPT FORMAT

Abstract. Must include a short abstract no more than 50 words that describe the significance of the article.

Length. Manuscript should be no longer than 15 double-spaced pages, excluding figures and illustrations. Manuscripts 10 pages or less will be printed in one issue. Entire manuscript must be submitted before any portion is printed. **Note: the numbering of teeth should be international numbering. (US numbering can be added and put in parentheses.)**

References. References must be included in the article and authors are responsible for the accuracy of references. Manuscripts without them will be returned. Cite references in the text as endnotes and number them consecutively. Citations must be referenced in the following style:
